
This Policy is prepared in accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 "General Data Protection Regulation" (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR"), and Directive 2002/58 "Privacy and Electronic Communications" (ePrivacy Directive).

This Policy provides you with information on what type of Personal Data is collected while you use the functionality of the <u>Website</u>, why it is collected and how it is processed. Within the scope of the Policy, you are a Personal Data Subject.

We recommend that you read the terms and conditions of the Policy before using the functionality of the <u>Website</u> and accepting this Policy.




1. TERMS AND DEFINITIONS

- **1.1.** Terms used in this Policy shall be interpreted in accordance with the following definitions:
 - **1.1.1. Personal Data** is any information directly or indirectly related to a Personal Data Subject. In accordance with GDPR, Personal Data of a Personal Data Subject shall be:
 - full name:
 - date and place of birth;
 - address of permanent and temporary residence;
 - mobile phone number;
 - information about family and social status;
 - information about education, profession and occupied position;
 - information about income and financial situation;
 - biometric data;
 - cookies (along with other Personal Data), etc.
 - **1.1.2. Processing of Personal Data** is any action (operation) or a set of actions (operations) with Personal Data using automation tools or without using such tools, including collection, recording, systematization, accumulation, storage, clarification (updating, modification), extraction, use, transfer (distribution, provision, access), anonymization, blocking, deletion, destruction of Personal Data and other actions.
 - **1.1.3.** Confidentiality of Personal Data is a requirement to prevent distribution of Personal Data without the consent of the Personal Data Subject or without any other legal grounds binding upon the Company.
 - **1.1.4. Personal Data Subject** is any natural person, whose Personal Data is subject to processing.

2. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- **2.1.** This Policy shall apply to legal relations that arise out of the use of the functionality of the <u>Website</u>.
- **2.2.** If you do not agree to the terms of the Policy, the Company will not be able to process your Personal Data, which will result in restriction of your use of the functionality of the <u>Website</u>.
- **2.3.** Changes and/or additions can be made to the Policy through publication of the updated Policy on the <u>Website</u>. The changes and/or additions shall be deemed




accepted the first time you use the functionality of the <u>Website</u> after the updated Policy is published. If you do not agree with any changes, the only way of protecting yourself from unauthorized Processing of Personal Data is to stop using the functionality of the <u>Website</u>.

2.4. The Company has no control over and shall not be responsible for the privacy practices of third-party resources. If you accept a privacy policy on a third-party resource, it shall not mean that you accept this Policy and vice versa. The Company has no control over and shall not be responsible for third-party resources that can be visited by clicking the links available on the <u>Website</u>.

3. SCOPE OF THE PRIVACY POLICY

- **3.1.** The Policy establishes the Company's non-disclosure obligations and ensures Confidentiality of Personal Data.
- **3.2.** The Company can obtain your Personal Data when you use the functionality of the Website. This Personal Data shall be:
 - full name;
 - telephone number;
 - e-mail;
 - your passport copy;
 - occupied position;
 - academic degree, academic rank, national awards, titles of honor;
 - involvement in projects, consulting;
 - experience in public activities;
 - country of citizenship;
 - correspondence address;
 - your signature scanned copy.
- **3.3.** The data obtained through automatic collection is considered analytical (statistical) and is not the data identifying a certain Personal Data Subject.
- **3.4.** The Company can obtain the following data through automatic collection:
 - IP addresses accessing the Website;
 - information from cookies (a small piece of data sent by a web server and stored on your computer, which is sent to the web server in an HTTP request each time you try to open the page of the corresponding website);
 - information about browser;
 - access time;




- referrer (address of the previous page);
- information related to how you interact with the Website.

4. PURPOSES OF COLLECTING PERSONAL DATA

- **4.1.** Personal Data is collected in order to:
 - optimize the operation of the Website;
 - protect against automated attacks and abuses/hacks;
 - improve the data collection, storage and processing methods to prevent unauthorized access to the Website;
 - measure the performance of the Website;
 - save settings and session (use of the website or app) data for further use;
 - analyze your use of the functionality of the Website;
 - provide information support should any issues related to the use of the functionality of the Website arise;
 - provide feedback, including sending notifications and requests regarding the use of the functionality of the <u>Website</u>, services, processing your requests and applications;
 - provide updates, special offers, information, newsletters, etc.;
 - monitor activity when using the functionality of the Website.
- **4.2.** All collected Personal Data shall be used for the specific above-mentioned purposes and only to the extent necessary for the full functioning of the <u>Website</u>.

5. METHODS FOR COLLECTING AND PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

- **5.1.** You are hereby notified that when you use the functionality of the <u>Website</u>, the Company can obtain data about the applications installed on the device and use this data to implement certain functions of the <u>Website</u>.
- **5.2.** The Company may send you a request for provision of Personal Data or for permission to process already available Personal Data.
- **5.3.** The <u>Website</u> uses protection tools to ensure security of your Personal Data. When servicing the <u>Website</u>, the Company receives information that allows detecting and automatically eliminating the components that pose a potential security threat to the <u>Website</u>.
- **5.4.** The Company uses a number of processes/methods for protecting the <u>Website</u> from unauthorized attempts to access, modify, disclose or destroy data.



- **5.5.** The <u>Website</u> can use third-party services that may collect your Personal Data. You can receive the up-to-date information on third-party service providers used on the <u>Website</u> through the feedback form on the <u>Website</u> by submitting the relevant request.
- **5.6.** The Company is entitled to transfer your Personal Data to third-party services (third parties) in order to:
 - optimize the operation of the Website;
 - render services related to the maintenance of the Website.
- **5.7.** Your Personal Data may be transferred to the authorized state authorities and/or competent organizations only on the basis and in the manner established by international laws and the laws of the country you are a resident of.
- **5.8.** Personal Data is provided to third-party services in accordance with the existing confidentiality requirements for the specific above-mentioned purposes, and only to the extent necessary for the full functioning of the <u>Website</u>.

6. COMPANY CONTACTS

- **6.1.** Messages or requests are sent to your actual residence address, e-mail address, telephone number or using any other means of communication you specified.
- **6.2.** You can contact the Company by contacting the Support Service on the Website.

7. COMPULSORY CONDITIONS

- **7.1.** In the case of the arising questions regarding this Policy, one should contact the Support Service on the Website.
- **7.2.** Only the Company shall make any changes and additions to the Policy.
- **7.3.** In case of any differences between various versions (printed, electronic, etc.) of the Policy, the electronic version currently available on the <u>Website</u> shall be deemed the official one.
- **7.4.** This Policy is translated into other languages for convenience only. In case of any differences in interpretation of this Policy, the version in Russian shall prevail.
